

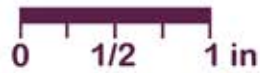
## Ring sizer

### 1/ PRINT THIS CHART

Prior to printing, ensure that Page Scaling is set to “None” on your print dialog box.

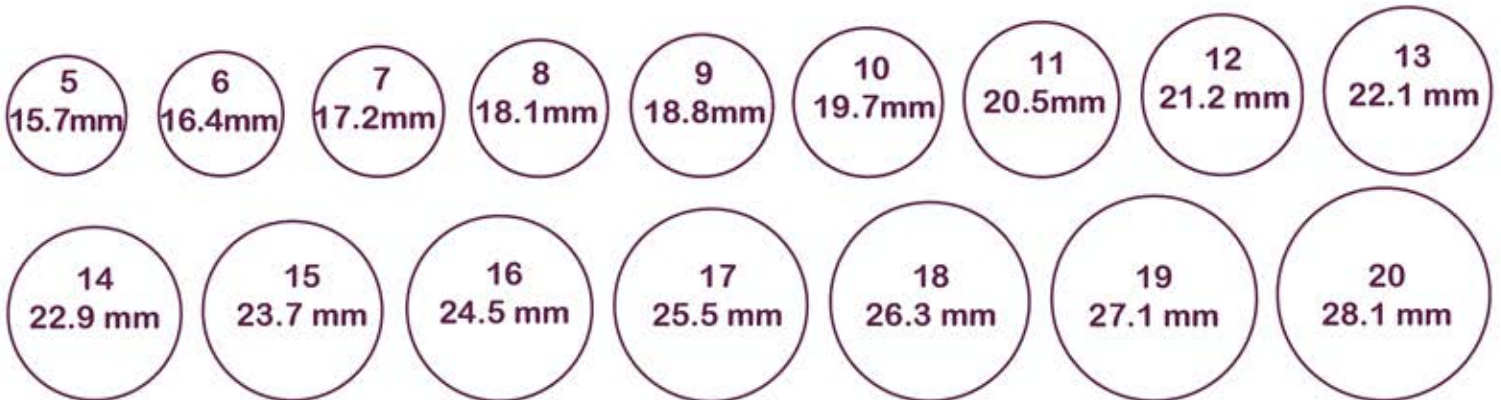
### 2/ CONFIRM THAT YOU PRINTED THE RING SIZER CORRECTLY.

Measure one of the bars using a ruler. This bar must measure to be exactly 1 inch (or 30 mm) long.

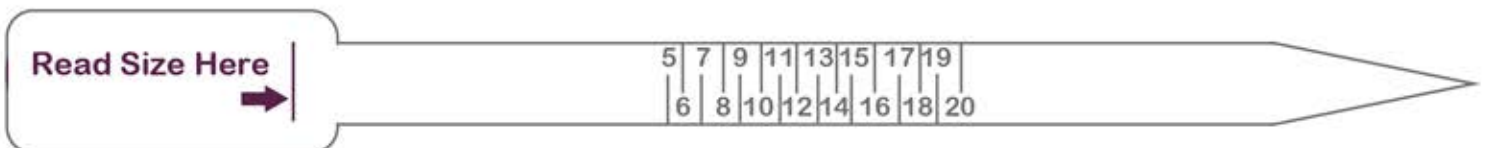


### 3/ FIND YOUR RING SIZE

**METHOD A:** Place a ring that fits you over the circle. Make sure the inside of the ring lines up with the outside of the circle. If you are between sizes, choose the larger size.



**METHOD B:** Cut out the ring sizer. Cut small slit that is marked with an arrow. Place ring sizer around finger by slipping pointed end through the slit, numbers facing out. Make sure that you can still slide the ring sizer over your knuckle at the same size. Your approximate ring size should be the number that appears at “Read Size Here”. If you are between sizes, order the larger size.
